The aim of ART is to give postgraduate training in clinical reflexology.

The concepts and techniques taught at Advanced Reflexology Training (ART) were formulated and adapted in 1989 by Anthony Porter to fulfil the demand by qualified reflexologists to study advanced techniques.

ART incorporates techniques and approaches which combine to create the most therapeutically effective reflexology method possible. A complete and comprehensive overview of the techniques is presented at ART seminars, held over two days.

Training is only available to qualified reflexologists.

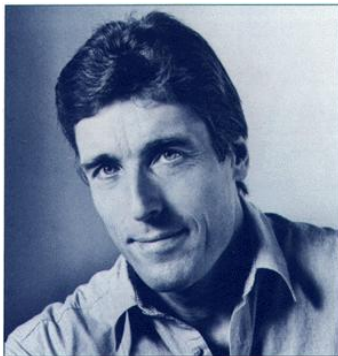
Therapists wishing to be included on the ART Register of Advanced Reflexologists have to be fully qualified at a recognised training school, and then attend at least three comprehensive ART seminars to become eligible for assessment. Successful completion of the assessment entitles the therapist to use the letters ART (Regd) after their name and to be added to the list of ART registered practitioners.

Because of the high standards of postgraduate tuition and assessment, patients are assured of the best possible practice of clinical reflexology.

ANTHONY PORTER

A practising reflexologist since 1972, Anthony has given many thousands of treatments and lectured internationally.



A qualified masseur, he first began practising reflexology in 1972, and from 1980 to 1991 he was the European director of an international reflexology training organisation. He relinquished the post in 1989 to focus on new directions in reflexology; new ideas that could be utilised alongside the more orthodox techniques applied by most reflexologists.

Many years of accumulated experience have led to the development of Advanced Reflexology Techniques, some of which are adapted and refined from existing practices, and others are his own discoveries.

Anthony is now concentrating on his own patients, but Sarah Tromans and a new generation of practitioners is continuing giving training in his techniques.

Anthony discovered that many ailments (presented by women in particular) are caused by hormonal imbalance - in particular hypothyroidism. This can be a major cause of many conditions, often unsuspected by medical and naturopathic practitioners alike. He discovered that a painful reflex does NOT always mean a pathological disturbance in a corresponding organ - it is the reflex texture which is more important, and in fact sensitive reflexes can mean a better prognosis for a sick patient.

The following year the Association of Reflexologists awarded him an Honorary Fellowship.*
